

Eaton Hall – The Grosvenor Estate - Landscape Remodelling

Project Brief:

Earthworks creating new contours and views to the east of the Estate. Remodelling, reconstruction and landscaping works to areas exceeding 10 acres of land with the 11,500 acre estate.



Project Overview

Extensive earthworks including harvesting of existing topsoil, cut and fill works and laser grading to remodel nearly 7.5 acres of land between the Estate's terraced gardens (many features of which are Grade II listed) and the 9 acre lake.

To improve accessibility, underfoot conditions and general presentation through and between the Estate's various formal gardens, woodland and Grade II listed features, numerous paths were excavated and reconstructed complete with subsurface drainage systems and geotextile reinforced formations.

Description of Main Project Elements:

- Earthworks involving cut & fill, laser grading over an area of 26,000m² to create new contours and views to the east of the Estate.
- Installation of subsoil drainage systems and construction of numerous inspection chambers.
- Re-profiling of the gardens to the lake enhancing the wonderful view of the historical grounds from the Hall. Cultivation, seeding and establishment of extensive grassed areas.
- Remodelling and reconstruction of 6680m² of garden paths across the Estate to enhance accessibility and improve underfoot conditions.
- Tree removal, tree planting and reconstruction of various formal lawned garden areas.
